Session 2: Gender perceptions and gender stereotyping

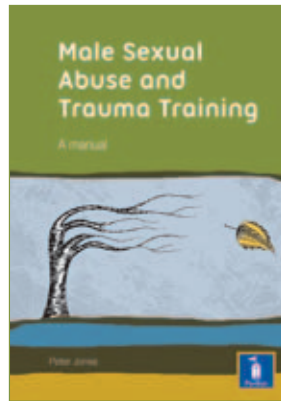
Session 3: Trauma, abuse and associated mental health issues
